

## **Minutes of the PAC Meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> February 2014**

- 1 The meeting opened with a prayer led by Fr Nicholas.
- 2 Present were: Fr Nick, Chris Moore, Ray Rose, Fran Grant, Margaret Campbell, Kath Parry, Gabrielle Stanley, John Wallin and Eddie Wyman. Apologies were received from Fran Smallwood and Brenda Ward.
- 3 The minutes of the last meeting were approved.
- 4 Matter arising: Spirituality in the Parish: at least five people had responded to the request in the newsletter regarding this. Fr Nicholas will contact them and ask them to come to a meeting in March to discuss how they can take their suggestions further. One of the suggestions was that there should be a group formed to discuss the readings for Sunday. Ray said that Margaret Rose was also thinking of restarting this as well.  
John Wallin would like to organise a get together to show his DVD of his Antique Road show trip.  
Chris will investigate the DVD “Why” and let the Parish know when and how this will be shown. This is a SFX initiative.
- 5 The Angel: Jacqui Ramage-Smith and Georgina McGurk are the team working on The Angel. Chris will ask Matt Corrigan if we could copy some things from his blog to include in the Angel.
- 6 Soldier to Saint – Ray has offered to print off more tickets and to overprint the posters. Chris will contact all the Deanery parishes with information about this performance and he will take posters to put up. Margaret said that she would be willing to sell tickets outside the porch.
- 7 The Parish website is up and running and comments are invited on how to enhance it and make it better. Chris will do a paragraph for the newsletter. The Parish facebook page is also up and running. It is hoped that the parish graveyard site will be resurrected soonest.
- 8 Fete Contributors: Fr Nicholas said we could write to Rude Wine and to All Pay and Margaret Campbell suggested Ascari.
- 9 Parish Registration: it has now been decided that we will use a small form and we will start the process the first Sunday in Lent. Everyone has offered to help with this.
- 10 Parish Update: Fr Nicholas reported that the new hall lighting was in place and everyone liked it. There is to be a Parish Choir dinner in February. Fr Nicholas was still trying to pin Tony down for a meeting to discuss the future of the choir.

He had approached two possible new Extraordinary Ministers and one new wedding “Registrar”.

There had been a recent finance meeting and everything seemed to be on budget.

Fr Nicholas is still looking for two volunteers to be our Deanery representatives.

There is a new initiative which is called “The Light is on for you” which means that most of the churches in the Diocese will have a priest ready to hear confessions on every Wednesday in Lent, excluding Ash Wednesday, starting at 7:00 pm. This will be published in the newsletter, on facebook and on the website.
